Application Guide

1. Qualification Requirements

- (1) The applicant must be a student in a medical / pharmaceutical science, bioscience, science, engineering or information-science related course at a designated university.
- (2) Fulfill the following conditions, receive the recommendation of a faculty head or senior faculty professor and the recommendation of a school.
- (3) Students who have decided to study in a Master's course from September/October 2013 or April 2014. (Foreign students may also apply.)
- * When you will transfer to another university, please apply from the university that you currently belong to.

2. Number of Scholarship Recipients

Master's course: 10 * Among these, about one person is a foreign student.

3. The view about selection

We select a scholarship student with grade and research level.

4. Selection Method

- (1) Preliminary selection
 - Screening of application materials
- (2) Secondary selection

Applicants who pass the preliminary selection will be screened in specialized interview.

- Medical / pharmaceutical
- Bioscience (bioscience, biology, environmental science, etc)
- Science (chemistry, physics, mathematics, material science, etc)
- Engineering (electrical/ electronic engineering, machine engineering, etc)
- Information science (information systems, electronic systems, etc)
- (3) Final selection

The foundation's selection committee will interview applicants who pass the secondary selection to determine the scholarship recipients.

5. Selection Schedule

- *Details of selection dates and locations, etc, will be announced separately to applicants.
- Students who are planning to study in a Doctor's course will be received in September 2014.

6. Documents Submitted (Application form can be download from Our Website)

(1) Teijin Scholarship Foundation Teijin Kumura Scholar Applicant's Statement (Use the designated form; attach a photograph): Submit a form signed by the applicant in person

- (2) Teijin Scholarship Foundation Teijin Kumura Scholar Recommendation Statement (Use the designated form): Submit a form created by the supervising professor
- (3) Evidence of academic achievements
- (4) 1 copy of a concise summary of 2-3 pages at A4 size of your current research brief
- (5) Written consent for the handling of personal information (Use the designated form): Submit a form signed by the applicant in person
- (6) Health certificate (The past less than 6 months)
- (7) Certificate of Eligibility (only foreign students)

7. Deadline for Application

March 13 th, 2014 (Thu) 3 5 recommendations per university

March 13 th, 2014 (Thu) International Student Office

8. Final Decision

The written notice of results for the Final selection process will be sent by mid-June, 2014.

9. Overview of Scholarship Handling

(1) Loan period

The loan period is the regular period from April 2014 to the completion of the Master's course. If an applicant wishes to apply for a loan for a Doctor's program continuing on from a Master's program, the applicant must undergo screening by the foundation after obtaining the recommendation of their school under the same conditions as other applicants. (If you study abroad, we stop the loan in accordiance with the rules.)

- (2) No need Scholarship repayments for foreign students.
- (3) Value of scholarship loan ¥80,000/ month (Master's course)
- (4) Commencement of loan From April 2014
 - * The 2013 fall-admissions person is also the same.
- (5) Loan method

The scholarship loan for 2-months is transferred into the scholarship recipient's personal account at a financial institution at the start of each even-numbered month.

- (6) Loan repayments
 - a) Scholarship recipients are excused from repayment if they engage in scientific research activities for a designated period at a university research organization, where designated by the foundation (corresponding to the organizations designated by Japan Student Services Organization).
 - b) In cases other than those described in a) above, the loan is to be repaid in half-yearly installments in a period less than 5 times the number of months of the scholarship loan period, it starting from 6 months after the completion of the loan period. However, the loan is interest free.
- (7) Other
 - a) We accept that you receive other scholarship.
 - b) Not obligated to join Teijin Limited.
