# Foreign Students' Main Roles

- 1) Give Japanese students opportunities to interact with you and other people from different cultures and show how important English is used to communicate with foreigners by only speaking English during the entire camp round.
- 2) When traveling on the bus with the students to Nasu, please try to interact and entertain them by playing games or singing songs.
- 3) You must participate in all activities at the camp (hiking & orienteering, International Cultural Performance, camp fire, chat room session, ice breaker games, etc...)

Important Note: We have experienced camp instructors to lead in most activities.

# Number of Foreign Students Needed

### 200-250 students.

# Eligibility

- 1) People who have the energy and enjoy being with young teenagers at the junior high school level.
- Must be proficient in English (regardless of nationality).
- Should be enrolled in a university in Japan (exchange students are accepted).
- Must pass an interview from ESC staff in June.
