Currently, there have been no reported or suspected cases of Covid-19 on the UEC campus. **All of the UEC campuses and offices are operating normally** and we are preparing for the 2020 academic year (starting on 1<sup>st</sup> April).

However, UEC is always stay alert and closely monitoring the latest information of the virus. The safety and well-being of the students and staff are our top priority. Well-established public health procedures, measures and reliable latest information are provided to all the students for managing the risk.

We will keep you informed of any changes or updates.

The following is some of our measures for the upcoming semester in April. We believe these will protect the international students from viruses and clear their vague fear, so they could concentrate on their research and studies.

- The new student is asked to self-monitor his/her health (such as measuring body temperature daily) for 14 days from the day of arrival at UEC. All students are required to practice good hygiene, and report to their program coordinator immediately if they have any cough, fever or respiratory symptoms.
- Any student who is not feeling well will have to stay in his/her room and is not allowed to join any lectures or activities. Our Healthcare center and International student office staffs are ready to provide the necessary and the highest level of support to the student until recovery.
- 3. Until the coronavirus situation resolved, every student is advised to wear a surgical mask when going into a crowd or joining the lecture.
- 4. Alcohol-based hand sanitizer is available in the dormitories and classrooms. Every student or lecturer has to wash his/her hands or use the hand sanitizer before entering the classroom, laboratory or returning to his/her room.
- 5. The facilities and services provided for the inbound exchange student are as follows. These should help avoid close contact with a large number of unspecified people.
  - UEC campus is one stop by bus from the airport (bus time 2 hours or less)
  - Every exchange student is staying at the on-campus dormitory in a private single room (with inroom kitchen, shower and toilet)
  - Classrooms, offices, shops, and any daily necessities can be accessed on a range of few minutes' walk.
  - Every lecture or activity offered is designed for less than 20 students/persons.
