
- We have established an entirely new educational and research system since academic year 2016, to enhance and strengthen our institution.

Students are required to take courses more than 10 hours/week in order to hold the resident status/ visa as "college student".

a) Short-term research student program. Short-term laboratory work for both under-graduate and graduate students.

5. Scholarship

A. Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship

(1) Scholarships for undergraduate and graduate research students recommended by Japanese Embassies

(2) Scholarships for international research students referred by UEC

These scholarships are available for the prospective students in the master's and doctoral programs. The scholarships are awarded based on your research field and qualifications. You may apply by contacting a prospective faculty supervisor or department head at UEC.

Currently UEC have 2 special programs with a period: One is MICH program, until enrolled in AY 2022 and the other is AiQuSci program until enrolled by AY2023.

6. Residences

There are a few options for the residence. We have a few types of dormitories for the international students at UEC Tokyo. Their rents are varied depending on the location and dormitory types (from 20,000 JPY to 60,000 JPY, including utilities).

Many of our international students live in the privately rented spaces (i.e. apartment) near the campus whose rent costs >40,000 JPY.

Depending on the programs, the admission processes are varied.



Application requirement

Applicants must meet all of the following 3 requirements:

(1) Those who do not have Japanese nationality and have completed or are expected to complete 12 years of school education out of Japan (including 11 years or more of school education separately designated by MEXT). For other qualifications, please contact us as soon as possible.

(2) Applicants must have taken the <u>EJU (Examination for Japanese University Admission for</u> <u>International Students 日本留学試験</u>) with the subjects of Japanese, Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics(Course 2), in June or November of the application academic year.

(3) Applicants must submit the original score sheet of either of TOEFL or TOEIC within two years before the April that you are planning to enroll in, and must meet the following criteria. TOEFL PBT 453 points or higher, TOEFL iBT 46 points or higher, TOEIC L&R 450 points or higher.

Note that the following applicant should be in the standard admission 一般選抜. Please contact UEC Admission Office or Int'l Student Office for more details.

(i) Applicant, who has non-Japanese nationality but has finished (or is expected to finish by the enrollment) a secondary education in Japan.

(ii) Applicant, who has Japanese nationality and has finished (or is expected to finish by the enrollment) a secondary education out of Japan.

Notes for application

- (1) To apply for the UEC entrance exam, you must obtain a booklet of Application Guideline for Admission of School of IE to Privately Funded International Students 情報理工学域 私費外国 人留学生選抜 学生募集要項 (available in early November). Screening Methods

You will be screened and evaluated comprehensively based on the results of EJU, academic achievement test and interview conducted by UEC, as well as academic performance reported by the school you are from:

(1) EJU 日本留学試験:

Subjects: Japanese, Sciences (Physics and Chemistry)*, Mathematics (Course 2)*
*You may choose either Japanese or English for the language used in these subjects. In case of you take EJU in both June and November, twice a year, the higher score will be regarded for your screening.

(2) On-campus academic achievement test, held on February 25

On-campus test is carried out only in Japanese language. The examinations of mathematics and sciences are the same as in the test of standard admission of School of Informatics and Engineering held on the same day. Examination fee costs 17,000JPY. The receipt for the fee must be pasted on the exam admission slip, attached in the Admission Guideline.

Entrance fee and tuition are 282,000JPY at the admission and 267,900JPY per semester, respectively.

None of the above fees will be returned once you pay and they are subject to change.

Application Requirement

Applicant should be either of the followings; 1)who has graduated from the <u>4-year undergraduate</u> <u>school</u>, 2) who is expected to graduate from the <u>4-year undergraduate school</u> by enrollment, or 3)who has not graduated from the 4-year undergraduate school but surpasses a undergraduate graduate in scholastic ability, may be accepted along with the pre-examination. If you are applying on 3), contact UEC Admission Office directly before more than a couple of months of the application.

Screening is held only in August. Applicant is able to choose, at the application, to start the program either starting in October right after the examination (so called Fall Semester Admission) or starting in April of the following academic year (Spring Semester Admission).

Screening Methods

You will be screened comprehensively based on academic achievement test, interview, and submitted documents.

The examinations on specialization is basically carried out in Japanese. Refer to the following URL for the copy of the exams in the latest 3 years:

1. English (100 points):

The score of TOEFL or TOEIC will be evaluated for your language (English) ability. Submit, along with your application documents, the original score sheet of TOEFL (PBT), TOEFL (iBT), or TOEIC which you took within two years before the month you take the screening examination.

Note that:

(1) The original you submit will be returned to you.

(2) The score sheet of group tests, such as TOEFL-ITP or TOEIC-IP, will not be accepted.

(3) Unless you submit the score with your application documents, your application will not be filed.

2. Specialization(400 points):

The exam content varies depending on the department of your interest. Refer to the Admission Guideline (in Japanese) or website of Overview of Admission.

3. Oral examination (100 points)

Examination fee costs 30,000JPY. The receipt for the fee must be pasted on the exam admission slip, attached in the Admission Guideline.

Screening Methods

1. English Ability (100 points):

The score of TOEFL or TOEIC will be evaluated for your language (English) ability. Submit, along with your application documents, the original score sheet of TOEFL (PBT), TOEFL (iBT), or TOEIC which you took within two years before the month you take the screening examination.

Note that:

(1) The original you submit will be returned to you.

(2) The score sheet of group tests, such as TOEFL-ITP or TOEIC-IP, will not be accepted.

(3) Unless you submit the score with your application documents, your application will not be filed.

2. Oral Examination:

You will be interviewed about academic achievement in your specialized subjects, thesis for master's degree, and plan of study. International students will also be tested on Japanese ability.
