Requirements for exchange students (Certain Majors required, Language ability for academic study, minimum GPA, etc.)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student study in the fields of Informatics, Sciences or Engineering in UEC's partner institution • Students need to be a 3rd or 4th year Undergraduate or a Graduate student during the time of enrollment to JUSST program • Good track of academic records with average scores at 80%+, 2.3+ out of GPA Scale 3.0, 3.0+ out of GPA Scale 4.0, or 5.5+ out of GPA Scale 7.0 • English language proficiency is required (such as TOEFL=iBT79+, IELTS=6.5+ or equivalent). Japanese language proficiency is not required.
